Guidelines in the Conduct of School Sports for SY 2019-2020

 Please be informed that all School Sports Activities shall commence in the month of August and be subsequently guided with the following schedule, to wit;

Only Pupils who were born on January 2007 onward are eligible to play in the elementary and students who were born in January 2002 onward are likewise eligible to play in the secondary.

- "No Original NSO Birth Certificate, No Play Policy" remains to be enforced starting from the lower Meets to avoid irregularities in the athlete's participation in the higher meets.
- All teachers (Except kinder & Grade 1) and Non- teaching personnel of DepEd (public & private) are eligible to coach provided they have attended relevant training/s, fit and duly recommended by the school head.
- Selection of athletes from the lower meets to higher meets shall be based from performance which will be recommended by the tournament managers and coaches.
- All forms of Solicitations for sports activities will be strictly prohibited however partnership with clubs, organizations, business establishments and individuals are encouraged to strengthen sports cooperation.
 - Policy on Child Protection should strictly be imposed in the conduct of lower meets. All
 means should be adopted to prevent case of bullying and other violations during the said
 events.
