- Pursuant to Republic Act (RA) No. 7079, otherwise known as the Campus Journalism Act of 1991,
 and in support to Tabuk City Division's desire to capacitate school paper advisers, a division training
 of school paper advisers on Campus Journalism will be conducted on August 21-23, 2019.
- 2. The training aims to:
 - a. Discuss the different genres in Campus Journalism and Campus Paper Management;
 - Capacitate the School paper advisers on the current trends and new developments in campus journalism and in digital communication media;
 - Provide a healthy forum in addressing issues and concerns relative to the conduct of the division press conference on October 2019.
- The participants to this training are the official school paper advisers with designation and currently involved in the production of school paper either in Filipino or English this school year 2019-2020.
- 4. A registration fee of Three hundred pesos (300.00) shall be collected from each participant to defray traveling expenses, accommodation, and honorarium of the three (3) speakers.
- 5. Participants are required to bring their laptops and extension cord to be used during the training.
- Since August 21, 2019 falls on a holiday, the participants are entitled for one (1) day service credit
 for teachers and one (1) day Compensatory overtime Credit (COC) for non Teaching Personnel in
 accordance with the provisions of DepEd Order no. 19, s, 2011, DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 CSC
 and DBM joint Circular No. 02, s. 2004.
- Registration fee and travel expenses of participants will be charged to local/school funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulation.
