Conduct of Dipstick Urine Screening of all Grade 6 pupils for Renal Disease

Control Program (RedCoP)

1. This is to inform all District Supervisors, School Heads, Grade 6 Teachers and all Elementary and Secondary Nurses that the conduct of dipstick urine screening to elementary schools will start on August 19, 2019 until September 30, 2019 in partnership with DOH CHD CAR and Provincial Health Office.

- The purpose of the urine screening is for the early detection and prevention of kidney diseases among school children and to manage treatment and referrals.
- It is requested that the Grade 6 Teachers and School Nurses assigned on the scheduled date of dipstick testing will participate in the collection of urine to grade 6 pupils on scheduled date of visitation.
- 4. Please instruct all grade 6 pupils to take a bath prior to the conduct of screening and instruct them to collect midstream urine sample. Proper coordination is necessary to have the activity done as scheduled by our respective Medical Technologies from Rural Health Units and Focal Division Nurses as follows:
