1. In line with Dep Ed Order No. 39 s. 2012, Policy Guidelines on Addressing Learning Gaps and Implementing a Reading and Writing Program , the division announces the conduct of the Search for the Best Reading Program Implementer for SY 2019-2020. The Search for the Best Reading Program Implementer is a division initiative anchored on Project T.R.I.P. Tabuk City Division Reading Intervention Program.
2. The search aims to :
 - a. Improve the reading skills of learners across all subject areas.
 - b. Encourage all schools to frame their programs and interventions as a proactive approach to the management of potential problems in learning beginning with a sound reading program.
 - c. Systematize the reading process and ensure systematic approach to bridge gaps in learning.
3. One time remediation is often not enough to bridge the gaps of learning. Sustained scaffolding with a lot of guidance from teachers until learners reach a level when they can learn on their own or to be more self-managing is encouraged. This aspect of the reading program will be monitored by the EPS in English and PSDS.
4. The Search has two categories: Elementary and Secondary. Implementation period starts from September to February 2020.
5. The Best Reading Program Implementer First Place winner in the Elementary and Secondary will receive Certificate of Recognition for the Reading Teacher and for the School Head.
6. Submission of Proposal for the Best Reading Program Implementer for the elementary and secondary schools will be on September 16, 2019. Validation and monitoring of entries will commence thereafter.
