1. Pursuant to provisions of Section 1, Rule IX of Republic Act 7079, also known as Campus Journalism Act of 1991, the Department of Education, Tabuk City Division announces the conduct of the 2019 Division Schools Press Conference with the Theme, "Empowering Communities through Campus Journalism", to be held on October 9-11, 2019. The venue will be announce later.

2. The Conference aims to:

- a. Select the best campus journalist who will serve as the Division's official entries to the Regional Schools Press Conference;
- b. Demonstrate understanding on the importance of journalism by expressing it through varied endeavors and approaches;
- c. Sustain advocacy on social consciousness;
- d. Provide a venue for enriching learning experience for students interested in pursuing journalism as a career;
- e. Promote responsible journalism and fair and ethical use of social media; and
- f. Enhance journalistic competence through healthy use of social media

3. Contest Categories

4. Participants:

Public and private elementary and secondary schools (including Junior and Senior High School)

- · One contestant each for the individual categories and medium
- One group each for team categories (7 members per team)
- A registration fee of one hundred pesos (100) shall be collected from each participant to defray traveling expenses, accommodation, and honorarium of speakers/judges
- A membership fee of P60/adviser or coach and P30/student shall be collected during the registration of participants.

7. Contest proper:

- For photo journalism, participants must bring their own camera with a maximum of 21.1 mp and empty memory card which shall be submitted for checking in the registration area.
- The top 7 winners will be announced for the individual events but only the top 5 will represent the division to the RSPC while in the group contest, the top 3 winners will be proclaimed but only the top one (1) will attend the RSPC.
- All participants must be in their civilian clothes but must always wear their School ID.
- The submission of a school paper dummy during the DSPC is not a requirement but the No school paper, no contest policy shall be strictly followed during the Regional Schools Press Conference on November 2019.
- Deadline of submission of School paper to the division office for judging will be on November 14, 2019 at 5:00pm.
- The SPA officers both elementary and secondary will be the facilitators for the different contested events and some advisers will be assigned as members of the different committees. (Please refer to the enclosure of this memorandum)
- 10. Transportation and other incidental expenses of the participants shall be charged against local and other available funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
