

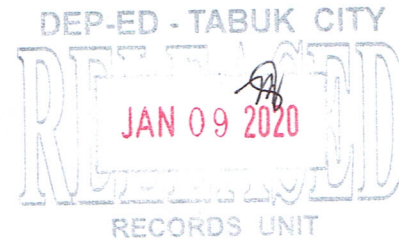

SUBJECT : **CONDUCT OF THE DIVISION ROLL-OUT ON THE CAPACITY BUILDING FOR RATERS ON THE NEXT 12 PPST INDICATORS OF THE RPMS**

1. Relative to DepEd Order No. 42 s. 2017, which directs the use of Philippine Professional Standards for Teachers(PPST) as the basis for all performance appraisals for teachers, the Schools Division of Tabuk City, through the Human Resource Training and Development Section will conduct the **Division Training of Raters on the Next 12 PPST Indicators of the RPMS** on the schedules as indicated on paragraph 3 at the Davidson Hotel, Bulanao, Tabuk City, Kalinga.
2. The activity aims to ensure that raters are able to effectively evaluate and support teacher's performance and development.
3. The participants are 1 school head and 1 master teacher of each school. Schedule is as follows:

| 3 | Batch 2 | January 22-24, 2020   | 1 School Head and 1 Master Teacher per school for NTD2, and WTD1          |
| 4 | Batch 3 | January 27-29,2020    | 1 School Head and 1 Master Teacher per school for NTD1, and WTD2          |
|   | Batch 4 | February 5-7, 2020    | 1 School Head and 1 Master Teacher per school for ETD1, ETD2, and ETD3    |

5. It is expected that all participants to this training shall roll-out the training to their respective schools.
