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SECOND QUARTER NSED 2021 MOBILE VIDEO MAKING CONTEST MECHANICS

Objective:

The contest aims to increase awareness and promote earthquake preparedness or readiness among people of the Cordillera Administrative Region during the COVID-19 Pandemic.

Qualifications

Open to all residents of the Cordillera Administrative Region, targeting amateur video-makers. Entry can be as an individual or a team (maximum of five members). One individual/team can only submit ONE entry. One person can only participate in ONE team.

Theme

The theme of the video is "Earthquake Readiness Amidst the COVID-19 Pandemic." In the midst of the COVID-19, people are not spared in the event that an earthquake will occur. This mobile video making contest aims to promote earthquake readiness, while adhering and incorporating minimum public health standards to help reduce the risk factors during the COVID-19 Pandemic. In addition, this mobile video making contest enjoins the participation of public and private stakeholders in observing public health precautionary measures in conducting earthquake drills.

Format

1. Videos can be in English or Tagalog.
2. Videos that are not in English or Tagalog must have English subtitles.
3. Videos should be 3 minutes long or less.
4. **All entries must be ORIGINAL.** The use of music or song in an entry must either be original, licensed or has obtained permission from the owner or composer (in accordance with copyright laws). Proper citation of information included in the videos is a must, giving credit to the original source/owner.
5. Video resolution should be at least 720p (1280x720).
6. Videos must be taken using a smartphone (Android or iOS) only.

Submission

1. First thirty (30) entries will only be entertained.
